

Testing 6.3

Initial setup and driving should be done in an open area free of obstacles until the user is fully capable of driving safely.

The product should always be tested without any person sitting in the wheelchair until every alteration of the physical installation or adjustment is complete.



- 1. Unzip the existing fabric cushion cover.
- 2. Remove the foam cushion from the existing fabric cover.
- 3. Insert the foam into the new cover, inserting the bottom first.


NOTICE

Keep the original orientation of the foam. It can help to fold the foam in half vertically.

4. Pull the top of the new cover over the top edge of the foam.

NOTICE

Some positioning may be required to align foam inside the new cover; do this by stretching the edges of the cover over the foam until it is aligned.



- 5. Remove existing JSP decal from the carbon fiber shell.
- 6. Clean the affected are of all adhesive residue with the provided alcohol wipe.
- 7. Remove all four Velcro strips from the inside of the carbon fiber shell. Clean the affected area of all adhesive residue with the provided alcohol wipe.
- 8. Cut 2in. Velcro to appropriate length, then remove the plastic adhesive cover and apply Velcro to the center of the inside of the carbon shell. Press down firmly to secure in place.

NOTICE

It is imperative that the original ROHO barcode label remains on the inside of the carbon shell. Please remove barcode label and place it to one side of the center Velcro strip.



- 9. Remove the plastic adhesive cover from the one inch wide Velcro. Place the Velcro strip along the exterior top edge of the carbon shell, horizontally. Place the strip as far down as necessary to avoid interference from the edge guard. (See example 1 above)
- 10. Stretch the flap of the cover down over the top edge of the carbon shell and secure it to the 1in. strip of Velcro.
- 11. Adhere the new JSP sticker to the exterior of the carbon fiber shell.

First Time Use 8.0

Dealer Assistance 8.1

During first time use by the client, it is advised that the dealer or service technician assists and explains the set-up to the customer (the user and/or the attendant). If needed, the dealer can make final adjustments.

⚠ CAUTION

Do not attach the back with the user in the chair.

User Testing 8.2

It is important that the customer is fully aware of the installation, how to use it, and what can be adjusted in order to gain as much mobility as possible. As a dealer, proceed as follows:

- Explain and show the customer how you have executed the installation, and explain the function of the hardware.
- Explain to the customer possible problems and how to address them.

Conditions of Use 8.3

The ADI hardware is intended for use as installed by the dealer, in accordance to the installation instructions in this manual.

↑ CAUTION

Do not use backs during vehicle transportation.

- The foreseen conditions of use are communicated by the dealer or service technician to the user and/or attendant during the first time use.
- If the usage conditions change significantly, please contact your dealer or a qualified service technician to avoid excessive wear and tear or unintended damage.
- The CF back may not fit every chair. Please consult your clinician or supplier providing your equipment.

⚠ CAUTION

Protect the back from blunt force shocks that may cause damage and/or breakage.

Maintenance 9.0

Cleaning 9.1

- Use a soft cloth to clean the back shell.
- Hand wash the foam pad cover with mild, soapy water or detergent and let it dry.
- Foam pad should NOT get wet.

A CAUTION

Institution MUST clean and disinfect product between multiple patient uses.

A WARNING

Do not wash or machine dry.

A WARNING

Do not hand wash in water temperatures over 160°F (70°C)

Disinfection 9.2

- Wipe gently with a cloth dampened with a household disinfectant.
- Allow foam to air dry thoroughly.

A WARNING

Do not immerse the foam in water

SAFETY

Always check all mounting hardware, making sure each fastener is properly tightened before using the back.

A WARNING
